Description: CD13,also known as Alanine Aminopeptidase,is a

aminopeptidase with broad specificity. It plays a role in the

final digestion of peptides generated from hydrolysis of

proteins by gastric and pancreatic proteases. May play a

critical role in the pathogenesis of cholesterol gallstone

disease. May be involved in the metabolism of regulatory

peptides of diverse cell types, responsible for the

processing of peptide hormones, such as angiotensin III and

IV, neuropeptides, and chemokines. It was found to cleave

antigen peptides bound to major histocompatibility complex

class II molecules of presenting cells and to degrade

neurotransmitters at synaptic junctions. Is also implicated as

a regulator of IL-8 bioavailability in the endometrium, and

therefore may contribute to the regulation of angiogenesis.it

is used as a biomarker to detect damage to the kidneys,

and that may be used to help diagnose certain kidney

disorders. It is used as a marker for acute myeloid leukemia

and plays a role in tumor invasion. In case of human

coronavirus 229E (HCoV-229E) infection, serves as

receptor for HCoV-229E spike glycoprotein. Mediates as

well human cytomegalovirus (HCMV) infection.
