Description: CD36, also known as FAT (fatty acid translocase), FAT/CD36, (FAT)/CD36, SCARB3, GP88, glycoprotein IV (gpIV), and glycoprotein IIIb (gpIIIb), is a member of the class B scavenger receptor family of cell surface proteins, which binds ligands including many collagen,thrombospondin,erythrocytes parasitized with density Plasmodium falciparum, oxidized low lipoprotein, native lipoproteins, oxidized phospholipids, and long-chain fatty acids. In rodent, it plays a clear role for CD36 in fatty acid metabolism, heart disease, taste, and dietary fat processing in the intestine, and implicated in association with obesity.CD36 is also involved in malaria parasite pathogenisis Type: Protein
