Description: CD43,known as sialophorin or Leukosialin,is a major

sialoglycoprotein on the surface of human T lymphocytes,

monocytes, granulocytes, and some B lymphocytes, which

appears to be important for immune function and may be

part of a physiologic ligand-receptor complex involved in

T-cell activation. During T-cell activation, CD43 is actively

removed from the T-cell-APC (antigen-presenting cell)

contact site thus suggesting a negative regulatory role in

adaptive immune response (By similarity). Defects in the

CD43 molecule are associated with the development of

Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome. Maybe a useful marker for B-cell

lymphoblastic lymphoma and intestinal MALTomas.
